

Who we are:

ArtCEE was born from a need in the community to have more **visual art** programs available in schools. By providing classes where primary age students can come together and make art for fun, ArtCEE is about meeting the needs of children and their families. Founder, Carlie Dole is a registered teacher who has specialised in the Arts for over 12 years.

The team at ArtCEE is passionate about being advocates for the creativity of children and use art as a way to support social and emotional wellbeing. With a diverse range of experience and expertise, ArtCEE is ready to bring art and craft into schools and OSHC programs to appeal to students that are artistically inclined OR those who just want to try something a little bit different!

After launching in Term 4 2022, ArtCEE is currently running a regular after-school program in seven primary schools across North Brisbane.

What we do:

As well as weekly classes we offer Incursion art workshops for students to engage, create and explore different materials and techniques in a fun and structured way. Projects have been lovingly crafted by an arts educator and are specifically tailored to support the development of students' creative and critical thinking. For classroom teachers, our workshops can also be aligned to the Australian Curriculum.

All materials are supplied with a focus on sustainability and recycling where appropriate. We are a team with over 15 years experience in the Arts and Education space. Our workshops are suitable for all students and abilities from prep-year six. Please see attached page for a list of our 2024 incursion workshops.

How we partner with your school or OSHC program:

ArtCEE is fully operational and independent of the school. We have public liability insurance, blue cards and all materials and equipment required.

To run a workshop at your school or centre, we simply request the following:

- A space with access to running water/sink (we can work around if required).
- Tables and a chair for each participating student.
- 1-2 hours workshop time



Costs:

Costs vary depending on the size and scope of the project. Workshops range from \$12-\$20 per student and can be found on the following page. For more bespoke programs, costs will be discussed further. Travel outside of Brisbane incurs a travel fee.
