Who we are:

By providing classes where primary age students can come together and make art for fun, ArtCEE is about meeting the needs of children and their families. What we do:

As well as weekly classes we offer Incursion art workshops for students to engage, create and explore different materials and techniques in a fun and structured way. Projects have been lovingly crafted by an arts educator and are specifically tailored to support the development of students' creative and critical thinking. For classroom teachers, our workshops can also be aligned to the Australian Curriculum.

All materials are supplied with a focus on sustainability and recycling where appropriate. We are a team with over 15 years experience in the Arts and Education space. Our workshops are suitable for all students and abilities from prep-year six. Please see attached page for a list of our 2024 incursion workshops.

How we partner with your school or OSHC program:

ArtCEE is fully operational and independent of the school. We have public liability insurance, blue cards and all materials and equipment required.

To run a workshop at your school or centre, we simply request the following:

- A space with access to running water/sink (we can work around if required).
- Tables and a chair for each participating student.
- 1 hour workshop time with groups of 20 participating at a time - the number of sessions is dependent on OSHC numbers.



Costs

Our OSHC incursions are priced at \$20 + gst per person with a \$400 + gst minimum. We will work with your individual centre to create a schedule of sessions to work with all students.

Please note, travel outside of Brisbane incurs a travel fee of .85 cents per km return to Newmarket, Brisbane.

Round canvases from unexpected materials create the BEST artworks! Let your creativity go wild as you play with pastels and paint markers on round, terracotta saucers.

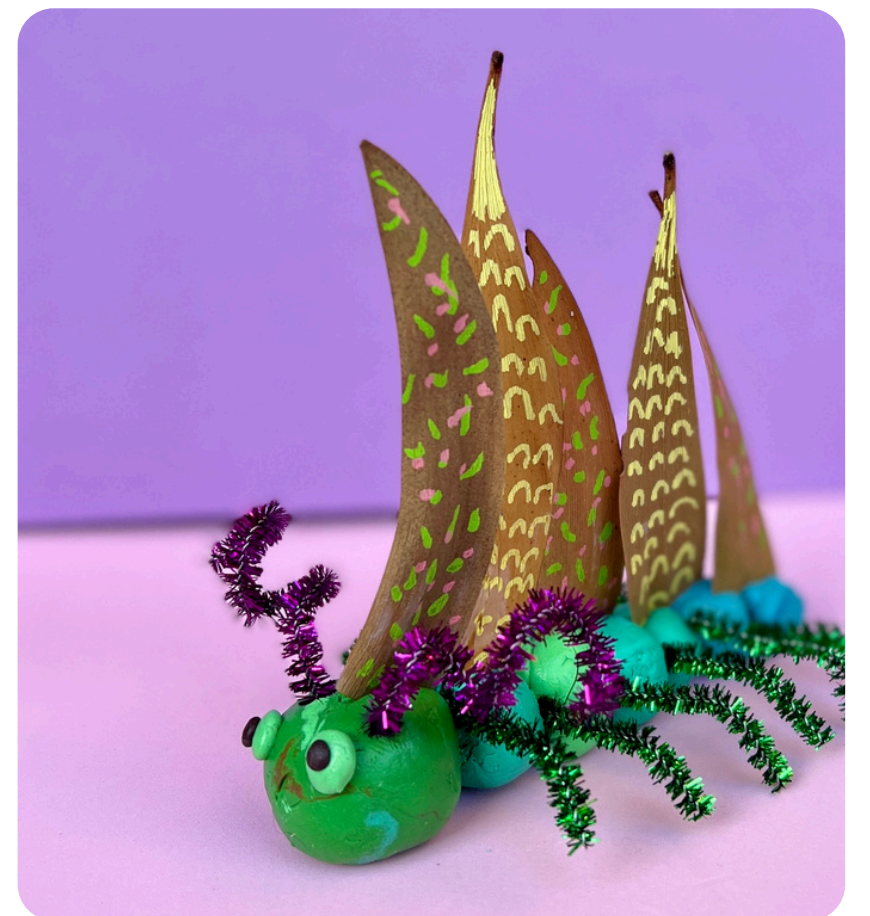
